

# CLIMATE CERTIFICATE 2018


CEMSAsys.com Climate Certificate™ is hereby issued to Phoenix Design Aid A/S which has purchased carbon credits for voluntary offsets of own greenhouse gas emissions equivalent to a total amount of 38 tonnes CO<sub>2</sub>-eq.

The emission credits related to this certificate are issued by UN and called CER (Certified Emission Reduction). The reduction of greenhouse gases is performed in the project called Curva de Rodas and La Pradera landfill gas management project in Colombia, registered as an UNFCCC' project (no 2183).

The project is part of UNFCCC' framework for flexible mechanism to combat global warming, which guarantees the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and supports sustainable growth in developing countries. When a carbon credit is issued the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions has already taken place. Without the certified emission reduction funding scheme the project would not have been proven economically viable and hence not realized.

The CERs purchased by Phoenix Design Aid A/S is registered in the European Union Registry for Emissions Trading and is hereby retired from the market. The CERs can consequently never be used again.
