CLIMATE CERTIFICATE 2019

CEMAsys' Climate Certificate™ is hereby issued to Phoenix Design Aid which has purchased carbon credits for voluntary offsets of own greenhouse gas emissions equivalent to a total amount of **30 tons of CO₂e**.

The emission credits related to this certificate are issued by UN and called CER (Certified Emission Reduction). The reduction of greenhouse gases is performed in a CDM project which produces electricity from agriculture biomass residuals in Maharashtra, India, registered as an UNFCCC' project with **CDM number 4078**.

The project is part of UNFCCC' framework for flexible mechanism to combat global warming, which guarantees the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and supports sustainable growth in developing countries. When a carbon credit is issued the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions has already taken place. Without the certified emission reduction funding scheme, the project would not have been proven economically viable and hence not realized.

The CERs purchased by Phoenix Design Aid is registered in the European Union Registry for Emissions Trading and is hereby retired from the market. The CERs can consequently never be used again.
